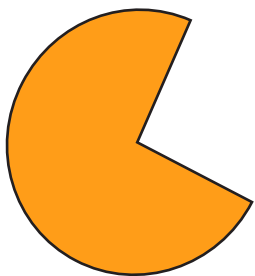

TEXANS SUPPORT LOCAL CONTROL TO ESTABLISH PAID SICK LEAVE POLICIES



74%

of Texans support allowing local governments to establish paid sick leave requirements.

Paid sick day policies support working Texans by giving them the right to earn paid time off when they or a family member gets sick, while ensuring they are able to maintain their income.

Poll conducted by Baseline & Associates, Inc. of 801 registered voters that participated in the last election across Texas. Half of those polled were via cell phone and the other half on landlines between February 13-19, 2019. Poll results represent a 95% confidence level with a +/-3.5 margin of error.
